Why Frontiers?

- The young boys develop basic moral virtues (fortitude, temperance, etc.) through simple talks and fun activities with each other and with their fathers.
- Talks for the fathers show them the importance of developing virtues and strong characters in their sons and give them practical advice on how to do this.
- Fathers have an opportunity to spend meaningful time with their sons.

What happens at Frontiers?

- 10-minute talk for the boys on some aspect of character which the fathers also attend.
- 30-minute creative, fun, and competitive activity for just the boys.
- 30-minute talk for the fathers on the virtues (during boys' activity).
- 60-minute physical activity for boys and fathers together (sports, games, etc.).
- Snack with general socializing among the fathers and sons.
- Throughout the afternoon, a priest is available for Confession.

Who can attend Frontiers?

Fathers and their 1st-4th grade sons.

When does Frontiers take place?

Bimonthly on the third Sunday of the month, 1-3 pm.

May 21

These dates coincide with the meetings of the Sherpa Club (grades 5-7). The schedules are coordinated so that a father with boys in both programs can attend both activities.
