- To engage in fun yet manly activities where they can develop their character
- To become friends with other boys who are developing their character

- To better understand and articulate the virtues and see how they can help their sons acquire them
- To have more occasions for the conversations they want to have with their sons about deeper subjects

Who can join Sherpa Club?

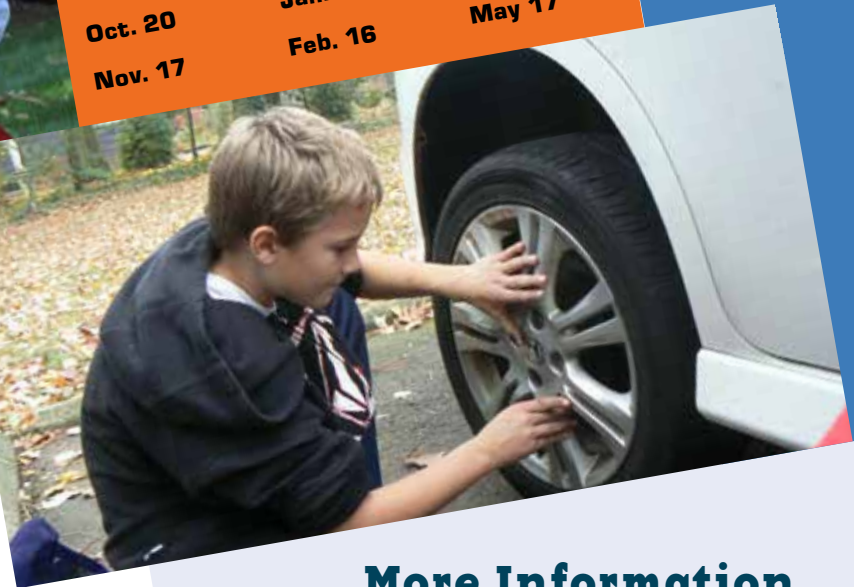
Fathers and their 5th-7th grade sons. Fathers are expected to attend the monthly meetings with their sons.

What Happens at Club Meetings?

- 20-minute talk for the boys on some aspect of character; the fathers also attend
- 30-minute activity for the boys of a creative or intellectual type like skits, magic tricks, charades, or jeopardy
- 50-minute more physical activity for boys with the fathers: sports or something like repairing bicycle flats or splitting logs and building a fire
- 30-minute talk for the fathers on the virtues (general aspects as well as specific virtues). This occurs during the activity period
- Concluding snack with general socializing of the fathers and sons
- A priest available for Confession throughout the afternoon
