Why Frontiers?

Frontiers helps young boys to develop the virtues necessary for manhood, especially fortitude and temperance, by fostering a stronger and deeper bond between each boy and his father. Each session offers boys a brief introduction to a virtue and an opportunity to engage in a challenge with his father. In addition, the club sessions feature discussions among fathers on best practices for raising their sons to be men of virtue.
